Thank you for your interest in the Toyota/Steve Young Scholar-Athlete Scholarship. This \$2,500 scholarship is awarded annually to one male and one female college-bound high school senior (\$2,500 each), whose academic and athletic careers have been exemplary and whose personal standards and accomplishments are a positive model for others.

Steve Young is an inducted member in the Bay Area Sports Hall of Fame and the National Football League (NFL) Pro Football Hall of Fame. He is the recipient of the Most Valuable Player (MVP) award for the San Francisco 49ers from Super Bowl XXIX and is currently an NFL analyst on ESPN. This scholarship was established in his honor in 2012 and is administered through the Bay Area Sports Hall of Fame. The scholarship presentations take place at the Annual Bay Area Sports Hall of Fame Enshrinement Banquet which will be on **Monday, May 21, 2018 at the St. Francis Hotel in San Francisco.**

- Include any High School Community Service/Volunteerism
